VISION 2033

Faith Comes By Hearing's goal is to work in partnership to record and freely provide God's audible Word in every language that needs it by the year 2033.

We call this massive effort **Vision 2033**. While there are many considerations when tackling such an audacious goal (audio recordings, Oral Bible Translations, military outreach, strategic devices for persecuted areas, group listening models, and broad, digital platforms), ultimately, our vision is about people.

The transforming power of the Word of God compels us to provide access to all 7.9 billion people living on Earth today. The vital influence of linguistic expression inspires us to share His Word in the intimate languages of the heart. The truth that faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the Word of God (Romans 10:17 NKJV™) spurs us to provide the world God's Word in audio.

Vision 2033—so that on the day when we are gathered at the throne, we will **hear** people from every nation say: *I had heard of you by the hearing of the ear, but now my eye sees you* (Job 42:5).

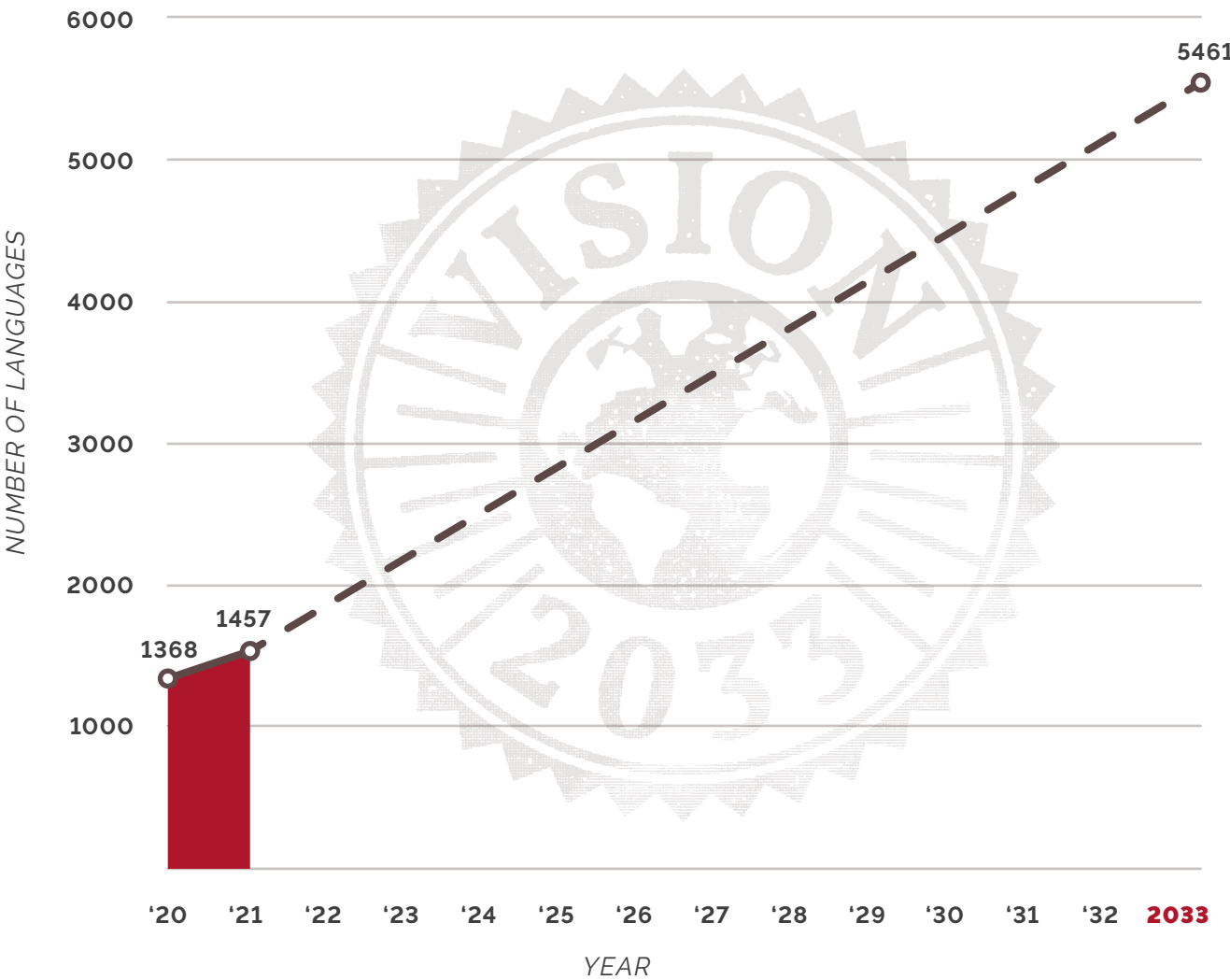

LISTEN

God has promised that when the Word is **heard**, it will not return to Him without first providing a harvest. Among the peoples living on the continent of Africa, Faith Comes By Hearing has seen this truth realized time and again—especially during the chaos of a pandemic and economic turmoil. Reports out of Africa tell of people in search of reassurance and comfort.

And they find what they seek in the audible Word of God.

AT THE DOOR

One Faith Comes By Hearing regional coordinator shared that with the cross-country shutdowns, she would not be able to travel from village to village to start Audio Bible listening programs. But to her unexpected and ecstatic joy, Christian leaders landed on this regional director's doorstep one by one, seeking Audio Bible devices in order to share God's promises with the growing number of people showing up on *their* doorsteps. Pastors testified of carrying Proclaimers—as many as they could get onto their bicycles—to not just churches, but communities that begged them to come. Where they could not go in and preach, a Proclaimer could ring out the promises of God.

THE UNEXPECTED

"One day, as we listened to the book of Revelation, a well-known non-believer passed by. I could tell by the man's expression that he was captivated by the Word. I invited him to join the ongoing discussion. Impressed by the Scriptures and biblical prophecies he **heard**, he urged us to cry out to God on behalf of humanity. Then he pleaded with us to give him an Audio Bible. Everyone in the group was profoundly affected by his appeal, realizing there is no one that God cannot touch."

The Bible Society of Mozambique reported, “With churches closed, the need for Scripture is even greater. Many people recognized that only God could save them from this situation. The Bible listening programs help people, communities, and churches by comforting them during the pandemic. Our God is merciful; He always helps us to find ways to take His Word to His people.”



VIRTUAL ENGAGEMENT

Nigeria is the most populous country and hosts the highest number of languages in Africa. There, God used Facebook and WhatsApp to connect more than 254,000 Pidgin speakers to His Word. Similar watching groups targeting Nigerian English, Igbo, and Yoruba speakers have started using the same model.

One of the most consistent members of this group wrote, "I am very grateful for the Bible studies we are having, even though they are virtual. They're really helping me."

HELD CAPTIVE BY COVID

After wrapping up six New Testament recordings in the Democratic Republic of the Congo (DRC) in May 2020, three Faith Comes By Hearing recording teams made plans to return to their homes in Ghana. But when COVID travel restrictions quickly spread across Africa and airports closed, the five workers were forced to move into a local apartment and wait.

As the days turned into weeks, and weeks into months, the teams stayed busy conducting morning exercise routines and visiting nearby farms. The men even planted a small garden in their compound. But separation from family members during a devastating pandemic took a toll on their emotions while COVID cases increased globally.

Finally, spirits lifted in August when the president of DRC announced the opening of all airports. Now, thankfully, passengers with a negative COVID test could travel. Flights were booked, but two of the teams’ members tested positive. The men refused to give up and pushed for more tests, suspecting false results. To everyone’s relief, all five tested negative on the third try.

On September 15, our five tenacious-but-weary recording specialists cleared customs and immigration in Accra and reunited with their families and workmates. Praise God! After six and a half months, they were finally set free.



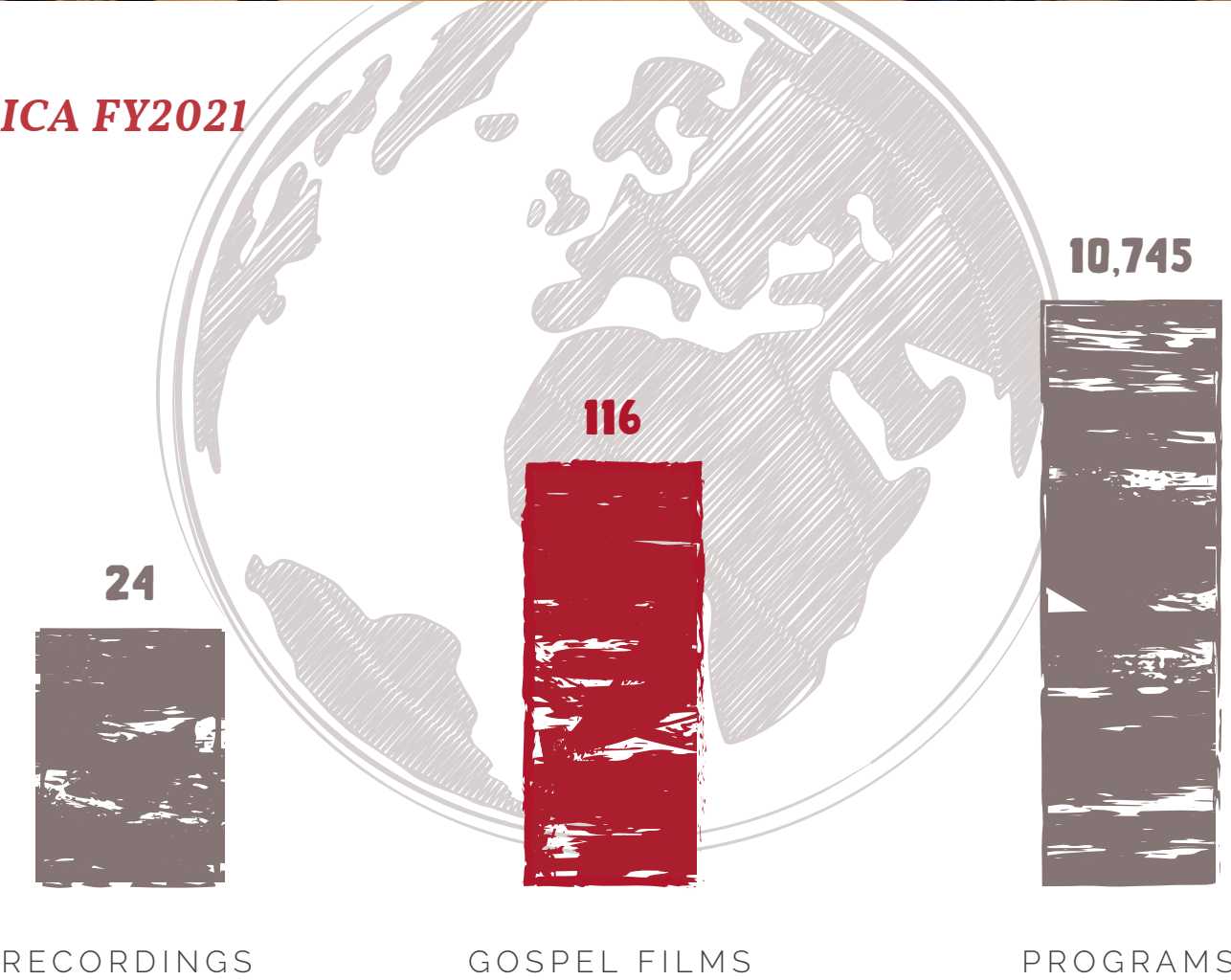
SOWING FUTURE SEEDS

THE WORD UNFOLDS

In Lima, Peru, alone, records show 2,000-plus people logging in to watch and interact with the videos on a weekly, and sometimes daily, basis. Families and small groups gather to watch, listen, and discuss. Statistics show that 86% of viewers share with others through their personal social media accounts.

MORE LIGHT EVERY DAY

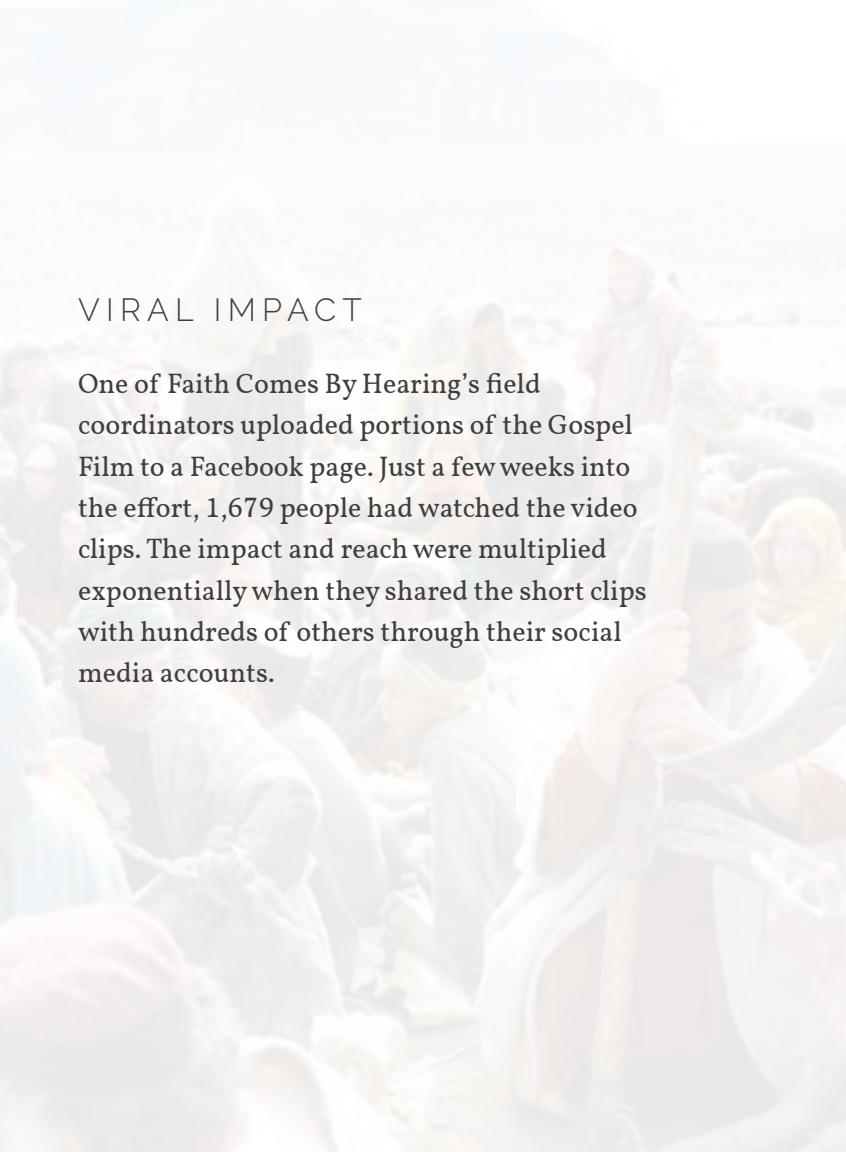

Light continues to shine in the Americas.

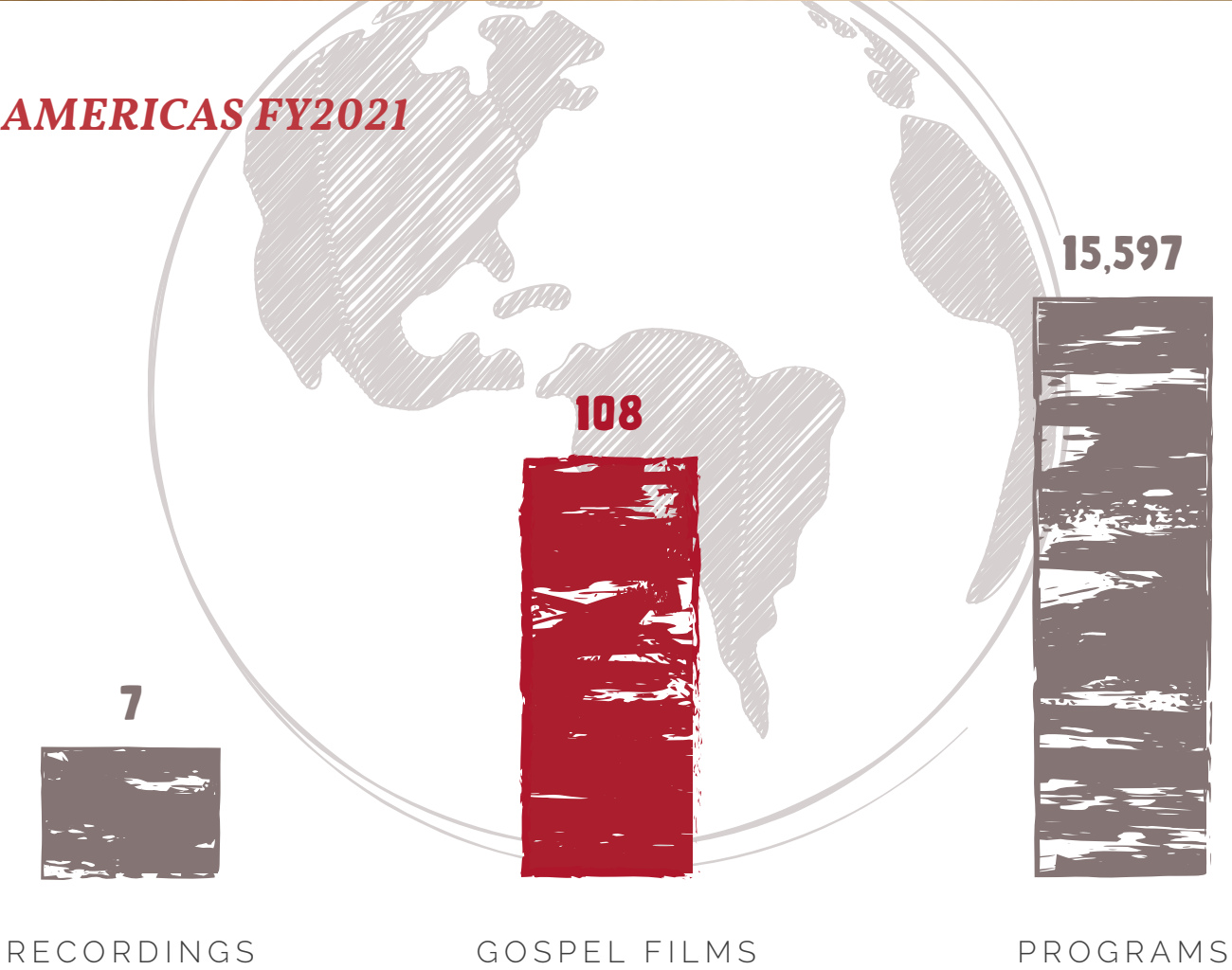


VIRAL IMPACT

Asia is home to millions of people and hosts some of the most neglected and forgotten communities on Earth. But praise be to God, thousands upon thousands **hear** the Truth in their own language. Working with determined Christians throughout Asia, we see God's Word spread farther and faster. Countrymen and women, seized by compassion, join the cause and lead their neighbors to freedom in Jesus.

These passionate Christ-followers know that it is the Word of God that will pierce the spirit and separate captive people from the oppression of false gods.



PRECIOUS COMMODITY

Divorced and destitute, Lin took care of her children by operating an unauthorized roadside store outside her village. Through the gift of an Audio Bible, she became a devoted follower of Jesus and played the device while she served customers. One day, the police raided her store and confiscated her goods, including her treasured Proclaimer. She snatched it out of the policeman's hands, shouting, "You can take everything, but not my Bible!" Moved, the policeman relented.

NOT BOUND BY BORDERS

James, a former Bible translator with SIL in a southeast Asian country, completed the Western Swa translation and helped Faith Comes By Hearing accomplish the New Testament recording in 2009. Believing that his work among the Swa was done, James and his family returned to the States. Several years later, civil unrest erupted in the country. Swa people fled the country in terror. Many came to the U.S. as refugees, seeking asylum, and were settled in cities around the country. One of these cities was Winston-Salem.

Delighted to be reacquainted with old friends, James and his wife resumed ministry among the people they loved. According to God's divine plan, Swa churches in the U.S. flourished and recognized the need for another Bible translation—this time in Eastern Swa.

Today, Faith Comes By Hearing is recording the Eastern Swa New Testament using our innovative Virtual Recording software. This multi-voice narration includes Swa readers from four cities around the country and progresses unhindered while a coup ensues back home. James smiles when he thinks about how God led him and his family to Winston-Salem at just the right time.



CHURCH-PLANTING DURING COVID

“We held two Sunday services in our newly planted house church in the Dhanas slums before the officials announced a citywide lockdown. The people in this area needed food and, most importantly, spiritual teaching. By God's grace, we assisted 55 families during this critical time. Out of the 55, 25 families accepted Jesus Christ as their Lord and Savior, and six new churches were planted. Because people living in the Dhanas are non-literate, the Audio Bible is the most effective way to share God's Word with them. They are hungry to know the Truth. Thank you for making this outreach possible.” – *a pastor's wife*

THE WORD PIERCES TENS OF THOUSANDS OF HEARTS

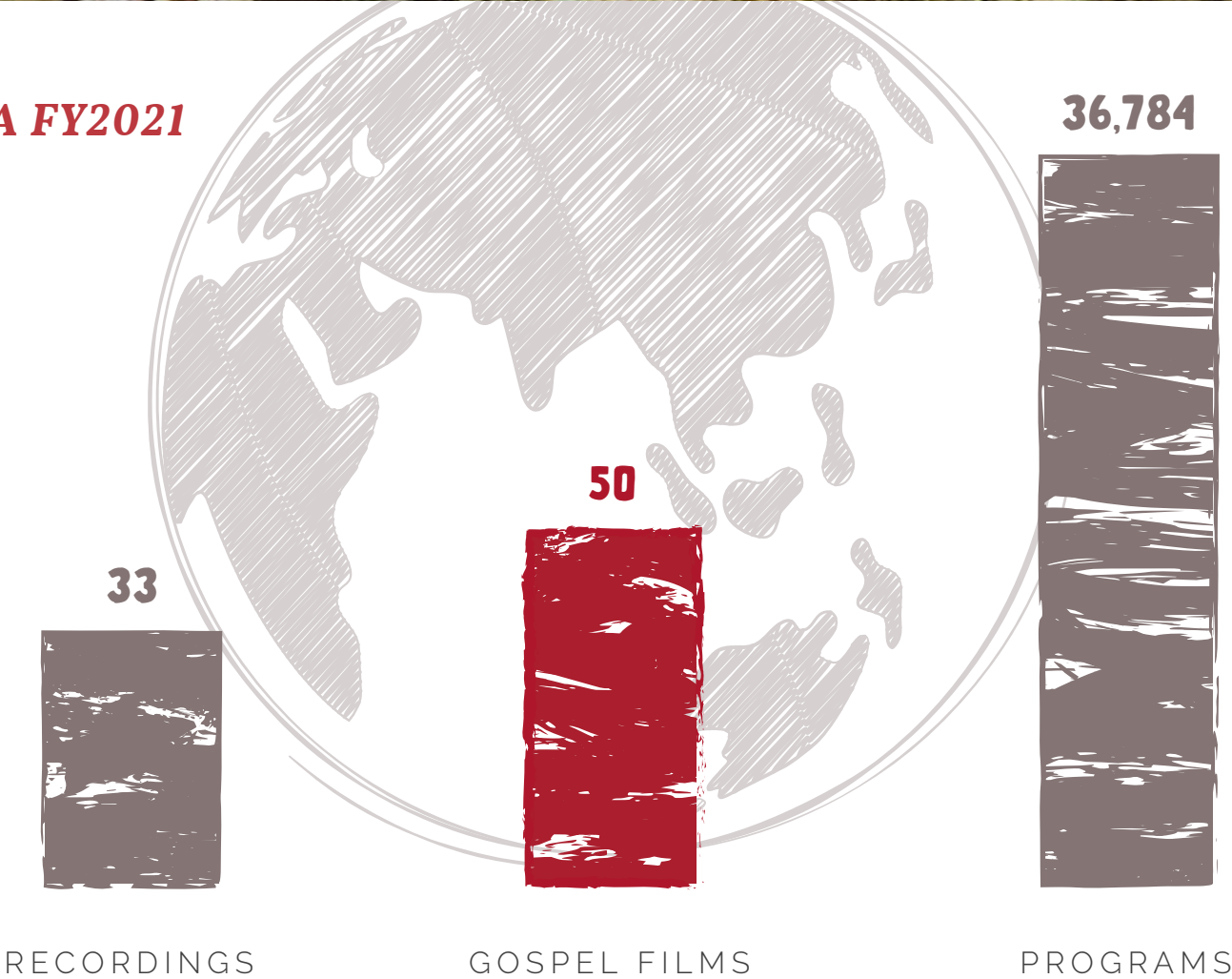

HOPE AT CHRISTMAS

In a Christmas season like no other, as the pandemic peaked, partners started a 21-day campaign in Malaysia and Indonesia that swept across Asia. A broad spectrum of churches sought to share extraordinary hope through both Bible listening and watching. Some saw Christ in His cultural setting for the first time. In one country, more than 400 people chose to follow Christ. Most churches and cell groups plan to continue.

ORAL BIBLE TRANSLATION

FOR THOSE WHO MIGHT NOT HEAR OTHERWISE

Essential to the completion of Vision 2033, Faith Comes By Hearing's Oral Bible Translation, or OBT, is revolutionizing the way we provide the Word of God.

Oral Bible Translation processes omit the need for a written translation, but maximize the skills of bilingual people to speak the Scriptures from one language into their heart language.

It starts with **hearing**.



THE FIRST TWO

Oral Bible Translation projects are generally composed of two translation teams that include two mother-tongue translators and a translation advisor. Since there were no known Christians among the Yari people, finding Bible translators proved to be difficult.

Unbeknownst to the project coordinator, God had already provided.

When a young Yari man named Jean Pierre became a Christian, his parents refused to keep him in their home. He had no option but to leave. As he found refuge and established a new life in the capital city, he prayed for his people to know Christ. Through surprising circumstances, he heard about the Yari Oral Bible Translation project and realized God was answering his prayers. He was the first of four chosen to translate the Bible. Hope for his people mounted in his heart.

The remaining translator positions were filled with non-believers. When one translator was asked what he learned from translating Scripture, he answered, "For me, everything is new! This is my first time to hear the stories of Jesus."

A third translator asked the translation advisor thoughtful questions like this one: "Since Jesus is no longer on the earth, how can someone know if He forgives sins?" As he explored who Jesus is and what he was learning, understanding dawned, and he trusted in Christ for salvation. Praise God—the Yari community now has at least two known believers. We trust that many more will believe as His Word is heard in their language.

TRANSFORMATION FROM THE BEGINNING

Less than five percent of the 30,000 Mahle people are Christians. So when the Oral Bible Translation project began, the advisors led mother-tongue translators in a Bible study to help them prepare for their work. The translators were diligent in their studies and grew passionate about reaching their people with the Word of God. Team members testified of personal transformation even as the project got off the ground.

Among the Koch people, only point two percent are Christians. One of their translators said, "When I was recording the translation, I didn't believe I could narrate the entire passage on my own. But as I did, I felt the Holy Spirit taking control. I became a whole new person when recording."

This year, in partnership, Faith Comes By Hearing began 10 Oral Bible Translations, preparing to give the great words of life in the heart language of people who may have no other way to **hear**.

HEARING THE WORD IN **EURASIA/MENA**

Oppressive religions can lead thousands of future Kingdom-dwellers down dark paths of deception. Thanks be to our Lord: He has opened unexpected doors in historically Gospel-resistant areas. Discreetly, and often one by one, Audio Bibles or online links are given to those who would not accept a printed Bible out of fear of discovery. With audio devices and secure digital technologies, God's Word is permeating this hard-to-reach area.

IN NUSHI'S WORDS

"I am Nushi. Desiring to be close to God, I asked a woman to teach me the ritual prayers of our religion. She gave me a notebook of prayers written in Arabic. I tried to memorize them, but I did not understand the meaning of the words. I could not find peace.

"I visited another woman who was said to pray—I asked questions about her beliefs in God. This woman was kind and gave me a Proclaimer, explained how to use it, and prayed for me. Since then, I have listened to the Audio Bible in my language every day.

"Shortly after, my husband joined me, and we listened together. We have a new atmosphere in our home after coming to know Jesus."

FAITH GREATER THAN OPPOSITION

Faithful to her traditional religion, Salima sought to know God. She was guided to watch a Gospel Film and was impressed by Jesus’ teachings. After watching, she had many questions, including, “Is Christ God?”

The Lord answered, reassuring her heart. Angry at what she had done, Salima’s family accused her of insanity and demon possession and restricted her use of the internet. She shared with our partner, “Christ the Lord is alive and with me. He is in my heart, and I will not retreat.”

SURPRISING RESULTS

The Ukrainian Bible Society made great use of the Gospel Film adapted with the new contemporary translation. Since COVID restrictions limited traditional Bible distribution methods, they opted instead to embrace their growing social media audience through a variety of online platforms.

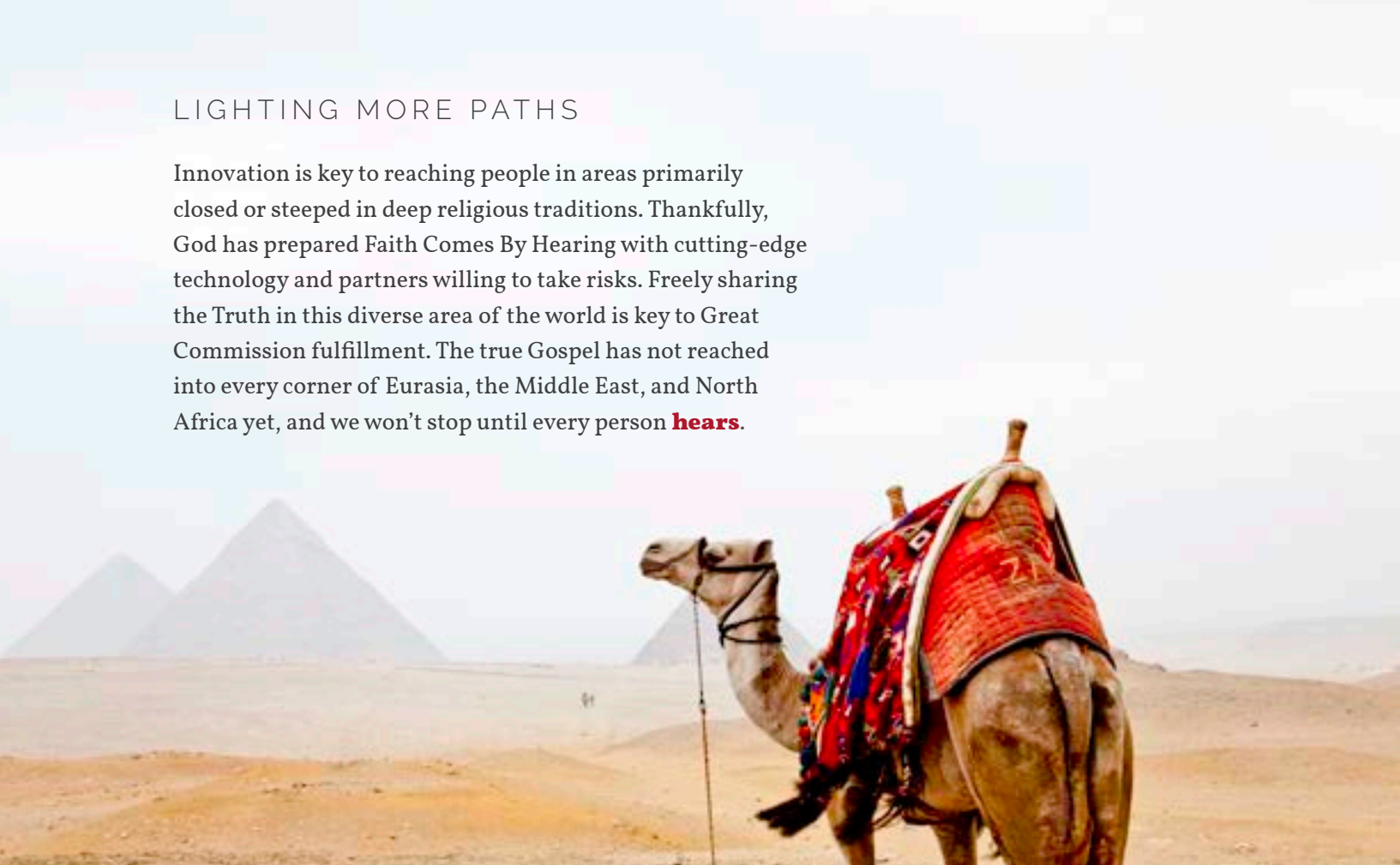
THE WORD SPREADS

LIGHTING MORE PATHS

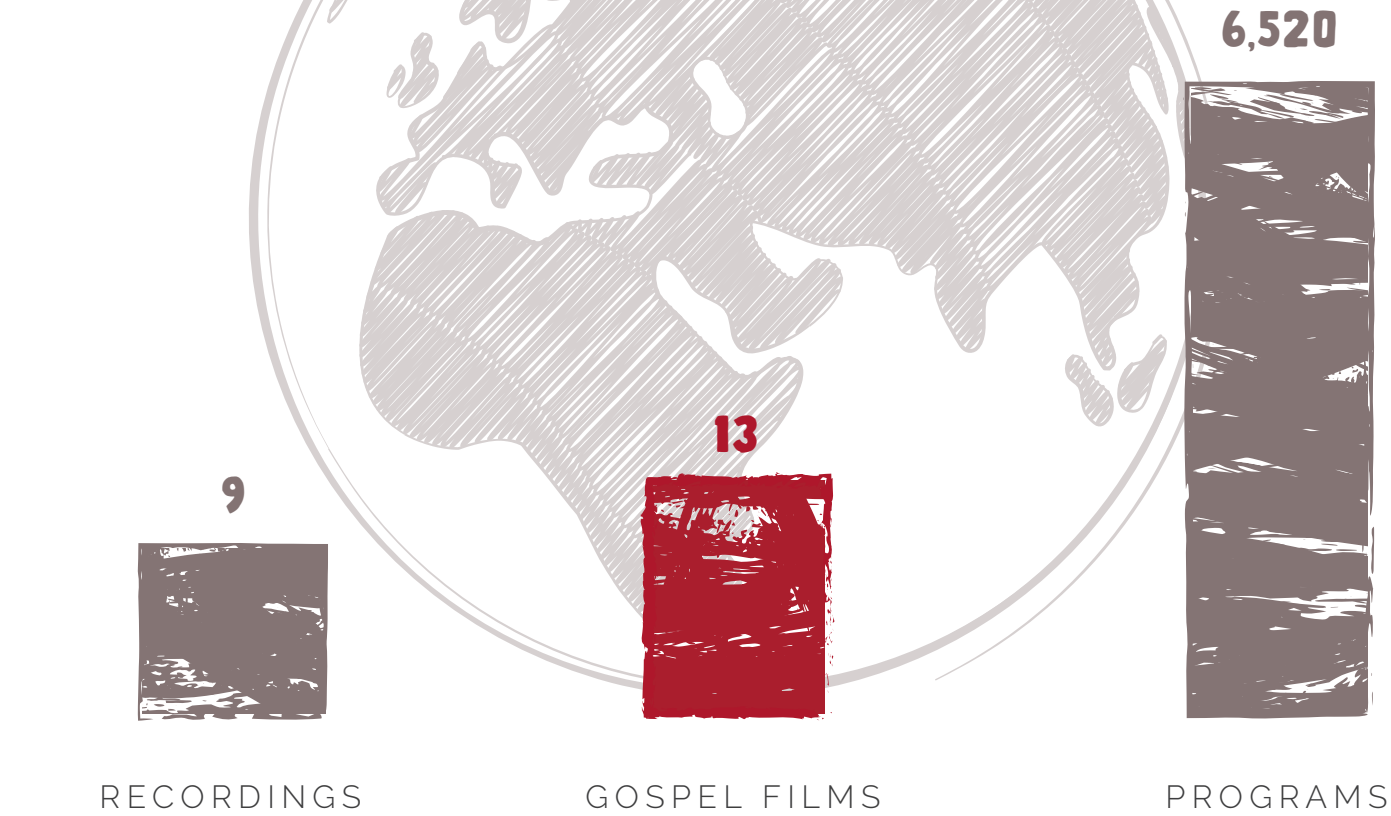

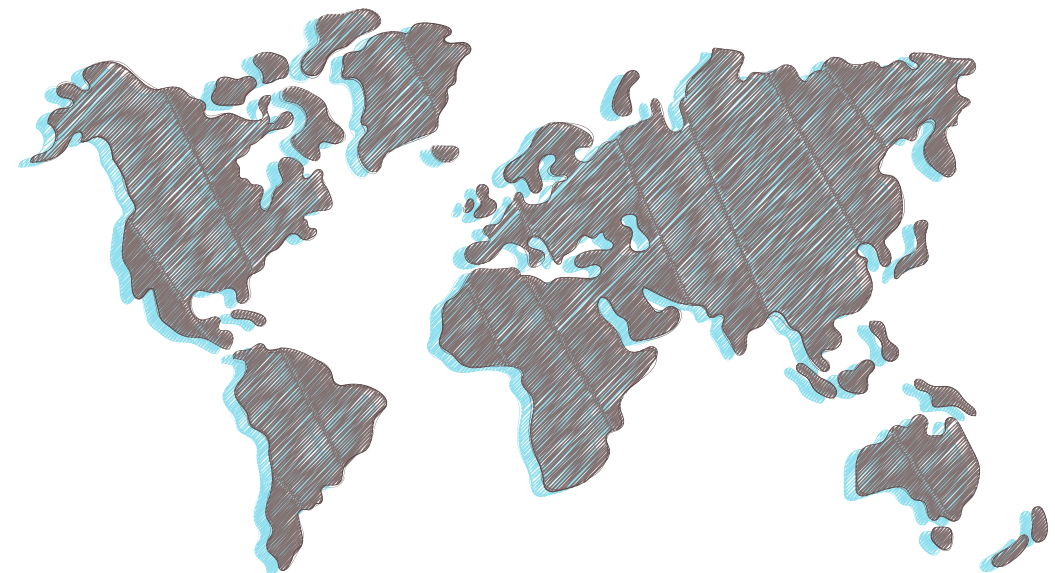
HEAR

In a world slipping further into darkness by the day, Christ-honoring acts of good works are imperative to support change. Because Scripture is God-breathed, we know transformation comes when people **hear** Him speak their language. Universal truths bring peace, security, and order. In the Pacific/Oceania region, Faith Comes By Hearing records and provides God's Word for the hundreds of language groups that have lived more than two thousand years without access to the very breath of God.

OBT ON THE MOVE

A cluster of four languages in Papua New Guinea is receiving the Bible for the first time using Oral Bible Translation. The Inebu One, Southern One, Muno, and Awtuw are small populations that range between 700 and 1,500 people.

A Southern One translator shared that for years, he sat in church unable to fully comprehend as the pastor taught from the Bible in Tok Pisin, the language of wider communication spoken in his country. He asked God to help him know what the Bible says. Now, as one of the translators on the OBT project, his understanding of Scripture grows daily.

EQUIPPING FOR THE GOOD

With the largest number of language groups yet to receive an Audio Bible recording, there remains significant work to accomplish in Pacific/Oceania. Faith Comes By Hearing’s plans include increasing capacity to record existing translations by every means available and offering Oral Bible Translation to communities that have no Scripture in their language. Oral Bible Translation and Audio Bible recordings remain a priority in this region to fulfill Vision 2033.



ENCOURAGED BY THE WORD

Jenny struggles with an eye disease, and her doctor recommended surgery. Unable to read, Jenny was given an Audio Bible by a partner of Faith Comes By Hearing. Even through her sickness, Jenny’s faith remains solid as she **hears** God’s promises, whether at home or in the hospital.

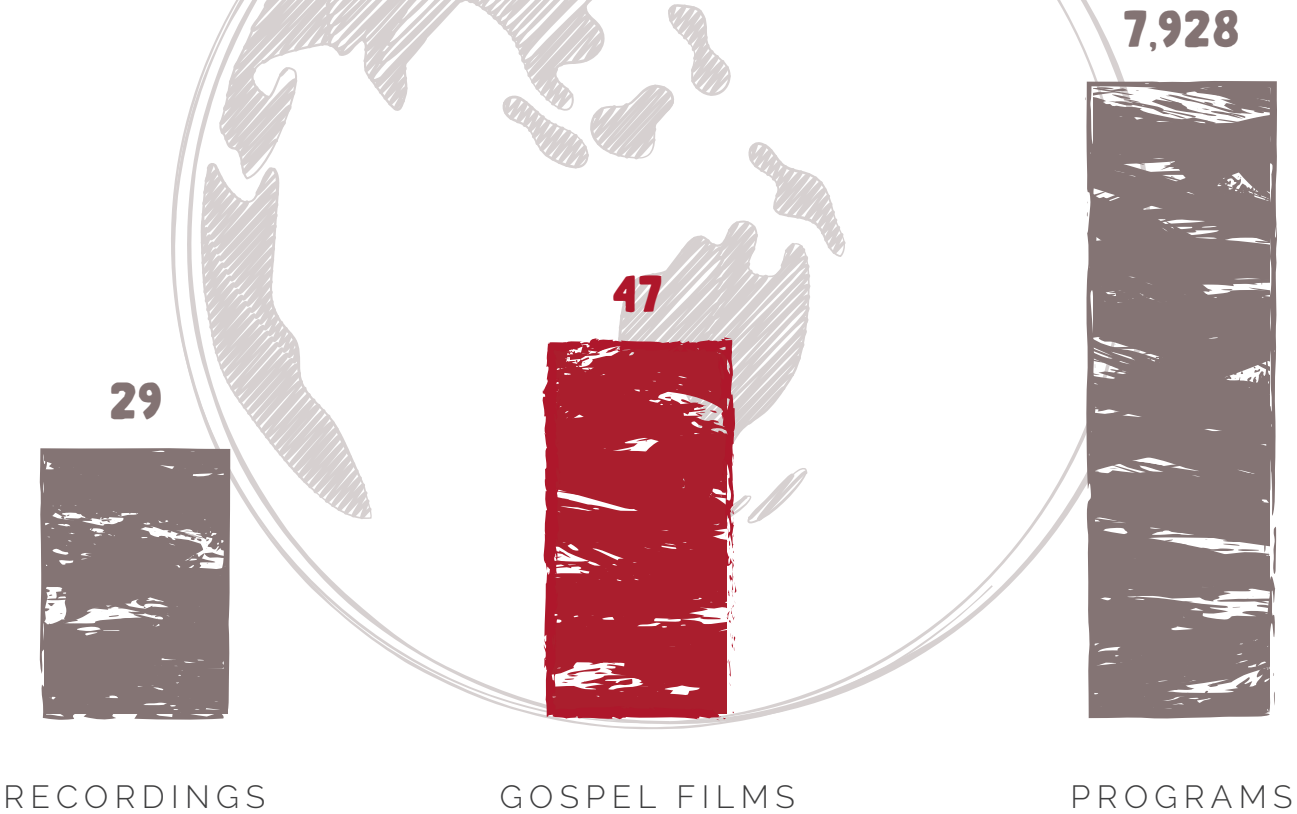
EAGER TO SEE AND HEAR JESUS
